## Some key takeaways:

- The park will open at approximately 50% of capacity with a mix of day-use and in-park overnight visitors
- Due to limited daily entry, day-use park visitors must pre-purchase a Private Vehicle
   Entrance reservation online for their planned entry date(s): Reservations available at
   <a href="https://www.recreation.gov/ticket/facility/300015">www.recreation.gov/ticket/facility/300015</a> starting on June 9th. Check the Frequently Asked
   Questions for reservation time frames and more important information about day-use
   reservations and permits. Bring proof of reservation and matching ID
- Pass Holders: Annual, Senior, Volunteer, Military, 4th Grade, Golden Age, and Golden Access
  Pass holders must obtain a Private Vehicle Entrance permit reservation for day-use entry. Pass
  holders do not need to pay the day-use fee, but do have to pay a registration fee. Bring proof of
  reservation and matching ID
- Visitors can also enter the park on YARTS (yarts.com) in a commercial tour operator vehicle you won't need to pre-purchase a permit reservation
- The Hetch Hetchy area is open with day-use reservations not required. However, access is limited when parking fills. Hetch Hetchy Road is only be open from 8 am to 5 pm. Day visitors must exit the area prior to 5 pm.
- The Yosemite Shuttle System within the park will not operate
